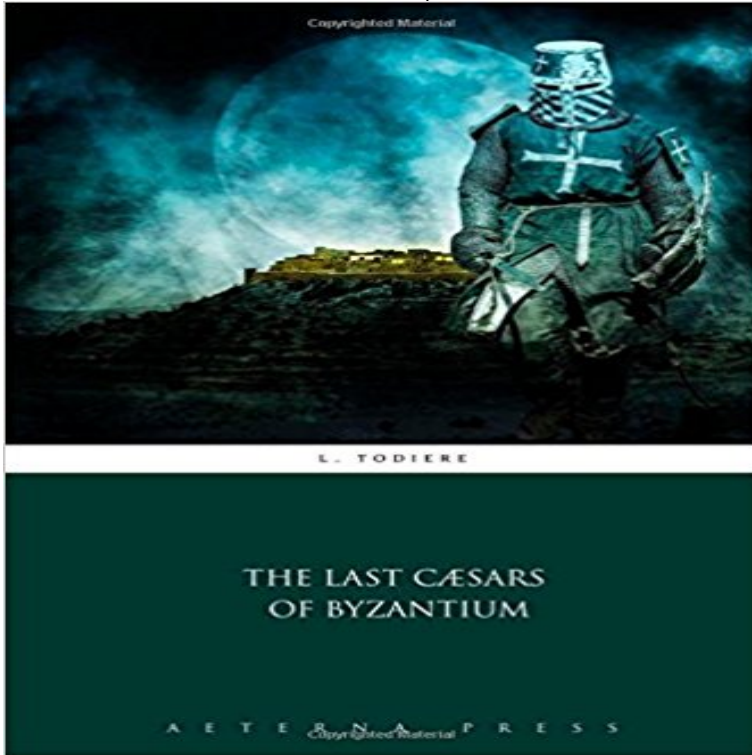


The Last Cæsars of Byzantium
