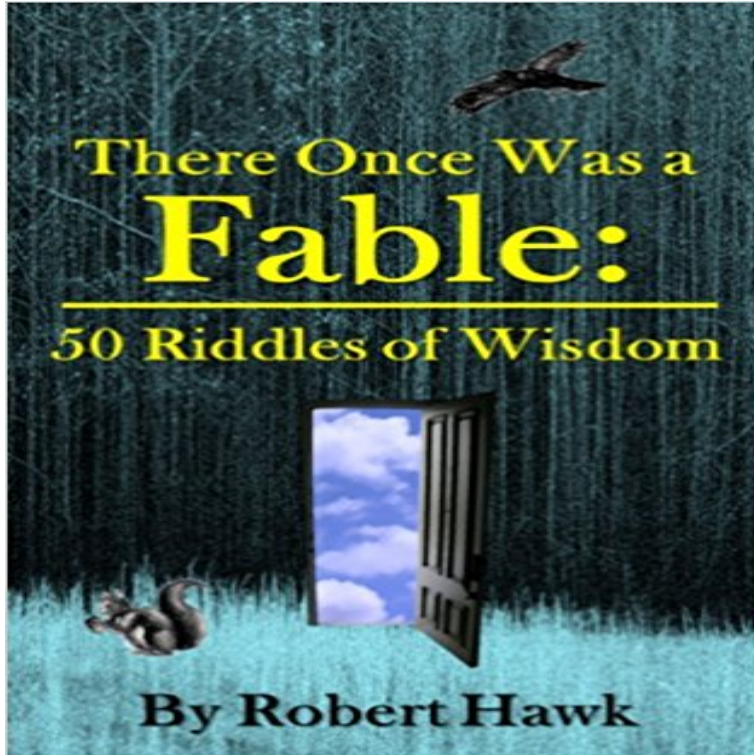


There Once Was a Fable: 50 Riddles of Wisdom
