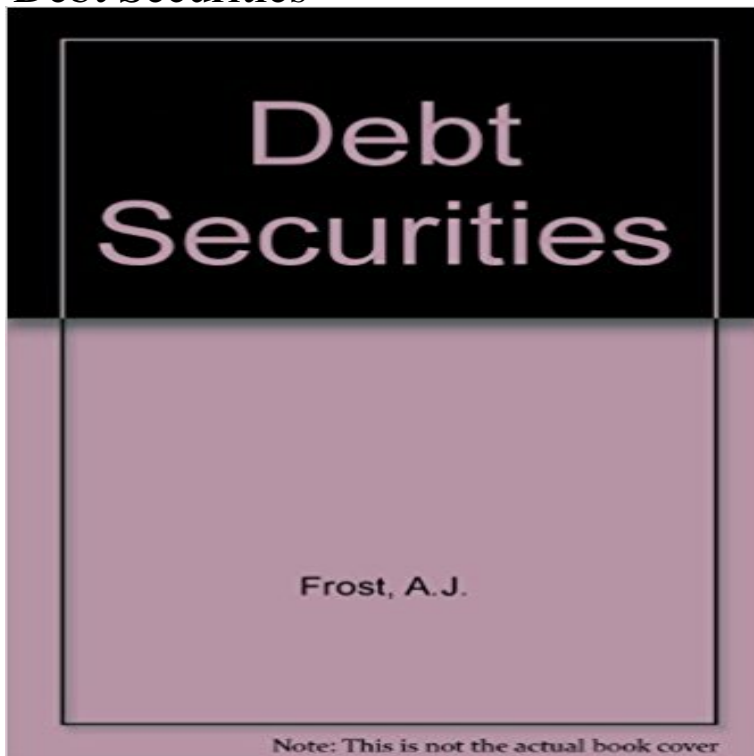


# Debt Securities
