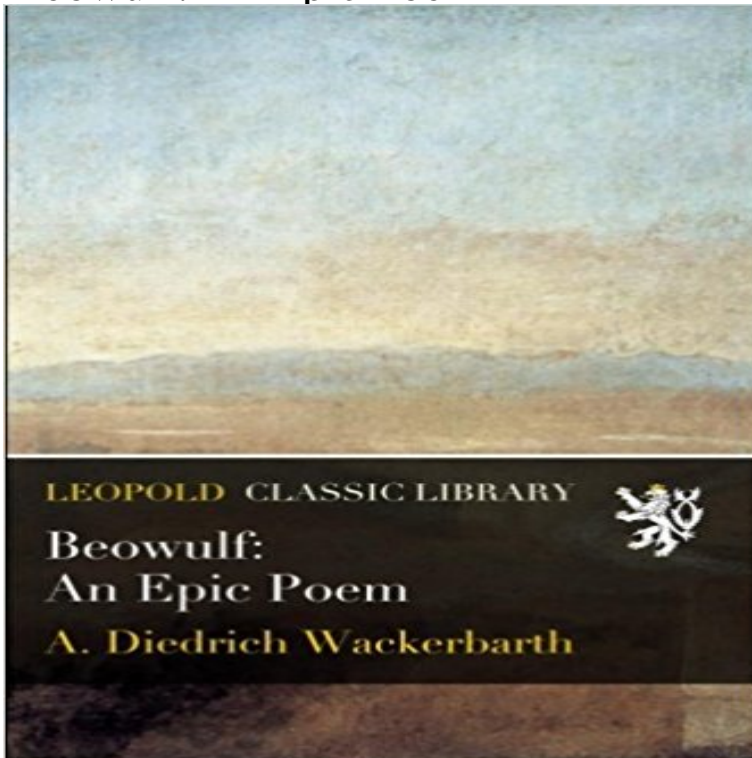


Beowulf: An Epic Poem
