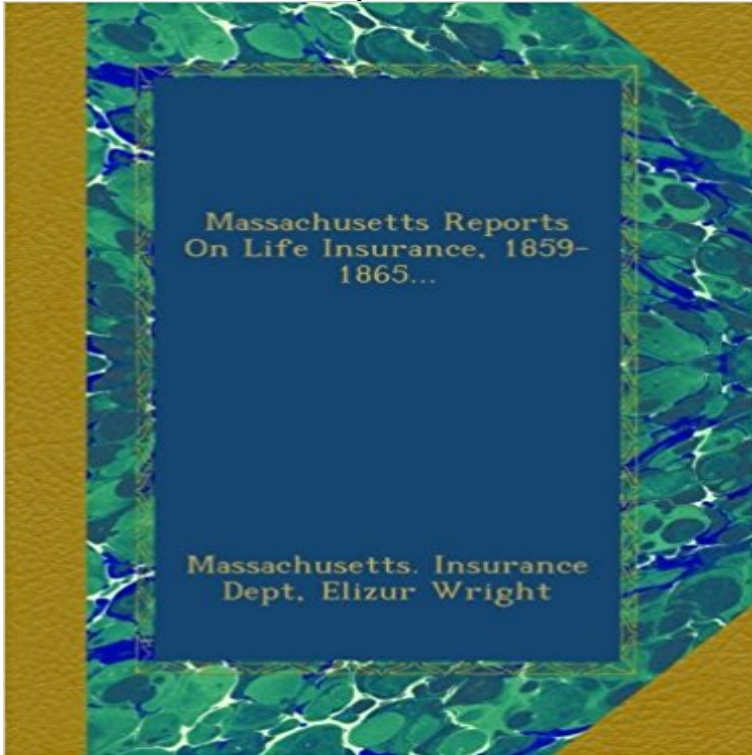


Massachusetts Reports On Life Insurance, 1859-1865...
