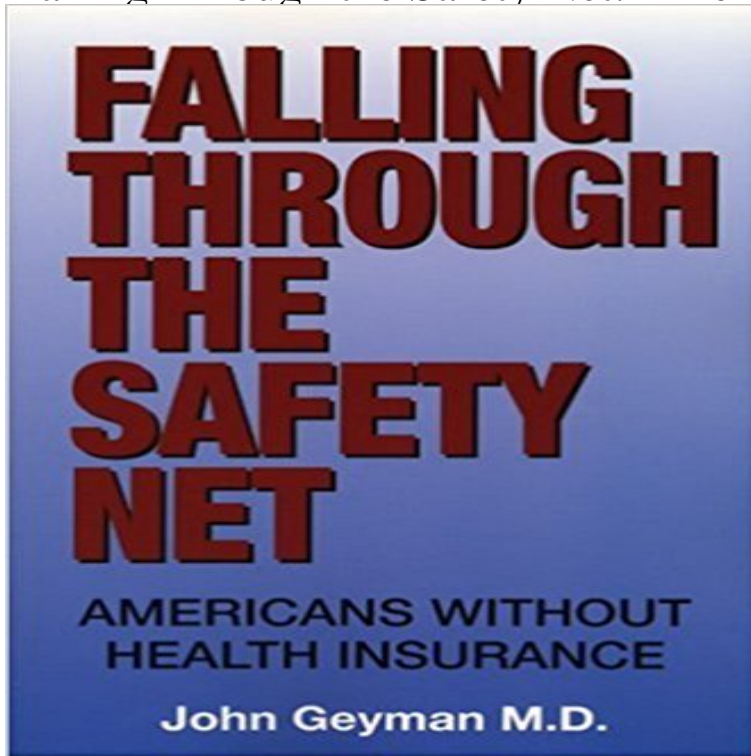


Falling Through the Safety Net: Americans without Health Insurance

Newman stance toward health insurance (What me worry, I'm healthy!), Geyman delivers some sobering statistics: Eighty percent of the uninsured live in working families; Sixty-seven million Americans are uninsured for at least one month in a twenty-eight month period; One in five workers cannot afford insurance when offered by employers; Even in families with two full-time wage earners, ten percent are uninsured. Those who lack insurance face poor health care and increased risk of bad outcomes. The answer, argues Dr. Geyman, is one the majority of Americans already want: single payer health insurance. This is the book for those who no longer want this problem to be as American as apple pie. John Geyman, M.D., is professor emeritus of Family Medicine at the University of Washington, and editor of the *Journal of the American Board of Family Practice*.
