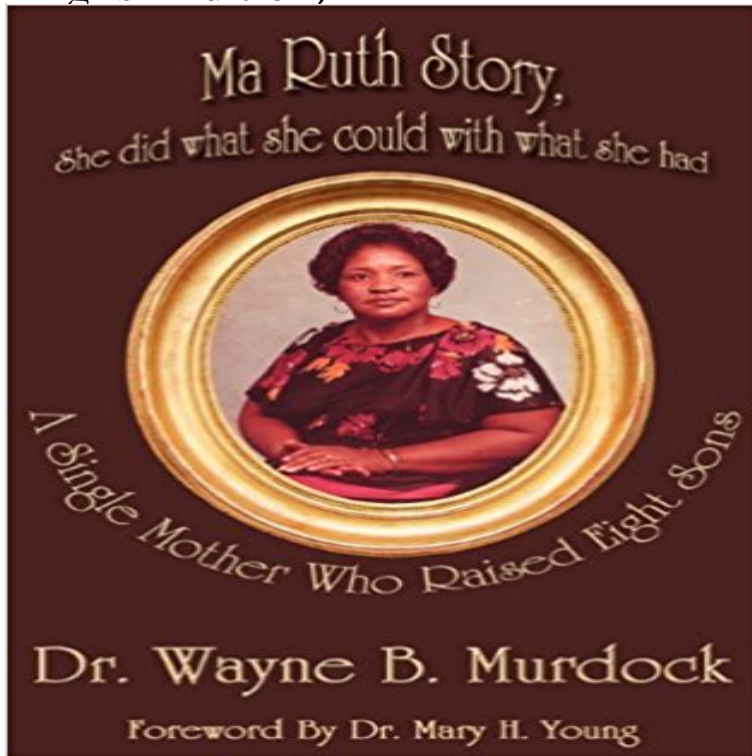


Ma Ruth Story, She Did What She Could with What She Had (Middle English Edition)
