

Crooked Spire to Eiffel Tower Charity Cycle Ride



Dementia costs the UK economy twice as much as the cost of cancer and three times the cost of heart disease, yet combined government and charitable investment in dementia research is 12 times lower than spending on cancer research and around 3 times lower than spending on heart disease research. These statistics show how little is spent on Alzheimers research, but estimates show that more of us are likely to suffer from this as advances in other areas of medical research mean that our bodies live longer. We shall enjoy greater physical longevity, but with what quality of life? I am inspired, not by statistics, but by personal experience: Fraser McLean, my father-in-law, was a decent, honest and good-humoured man who worked hard all his life, provided for his family and paid all his taxes, but whom we sadly lost to Alzheimers in January this year. The overall support he and the family received was not good; there were individuals who were fantastic, but the government stance on, and funding of, Alzheimers care and research is not appropriate to the demands of the disease. Finding local care homes for respite, and finally full-time residence, that are able to accept Alzheimers patients proved an almost impossible task. This disease robs individuals of their dignity and families of their loved ones in a slow, cruel and painful manner. There were good days and bad days, a few smiles and many anguished tears. At the end there was the ultimate loss, but this was the conclusion of a frustrating decline over a three year period that makes it difficult to remember Fraser as the steadfast gentleman with a sharp, dry wit who was so well loved and respected by family, friends and the community in which he lived. The Alzheimers Society hold a cycling event from London to Paris, but it seemed more appropriate for me to cycle from the Crooked Spire, a well-known Derbyshire landmark, to the Eiffel Tower, a

well-known French landmark. I had never cycled such a distance before, some 500 miles in total, but attempted this challenge in memory of Fraser, to raise awareness of the need for more research into dementia, to raise some valuable funding for this research and so to offer hope to people who are now, and who may be in the future, affected by this disease. This book is a compilation of the posts I made on the Posterous website on the preparations for the ride in the preceding months, during the ride and in summary afterwards. They are a personal record of my biggest cycling achievement to date and all proceeds from this Kindle book will be given to the Alzheimers Society.
