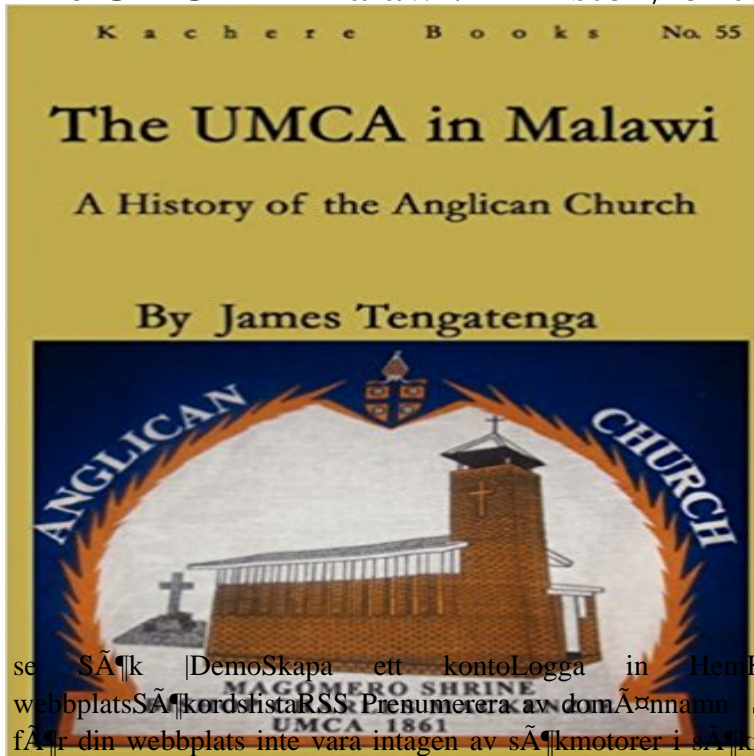


The UMCA in Malawi. A History of the Anglican Church 1861-2010
