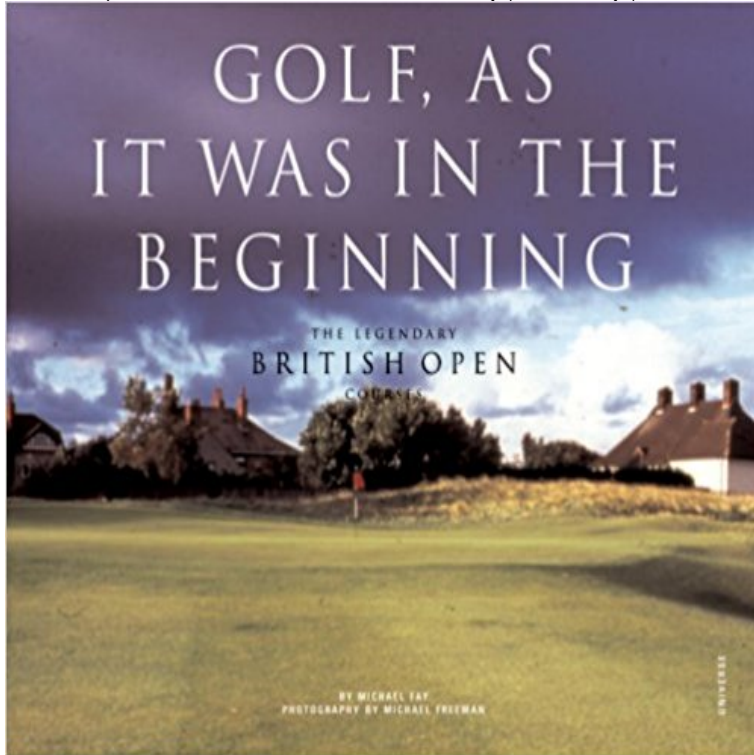


Golf, As it was in the Beginning: The Legendary British Open Courses
