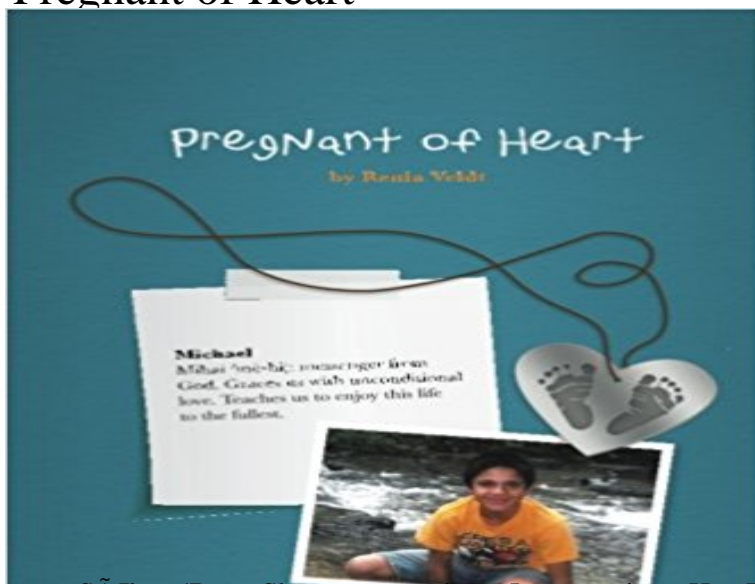


# Pregnant of Heart
