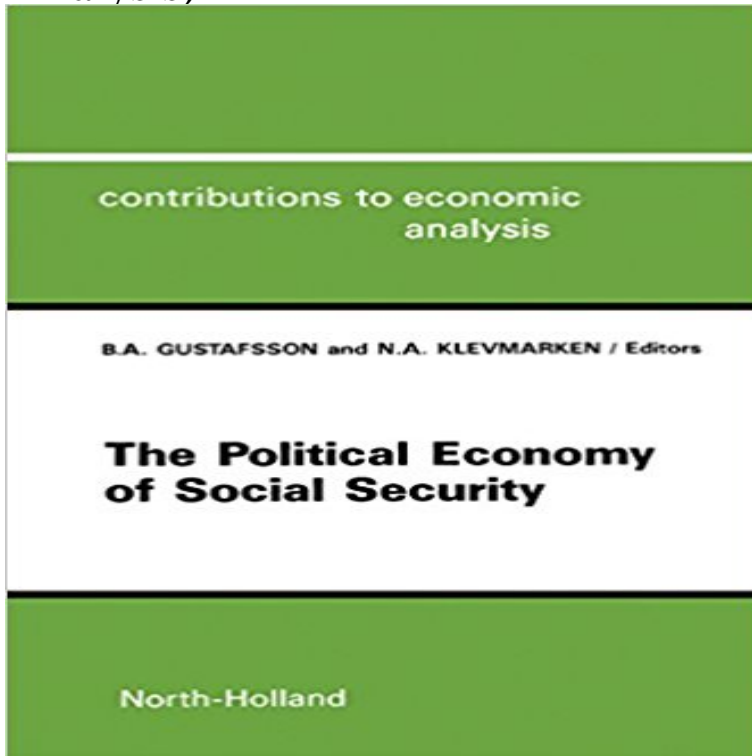


The Political Economy of Social Security (Contributions to Economic Analysis)
