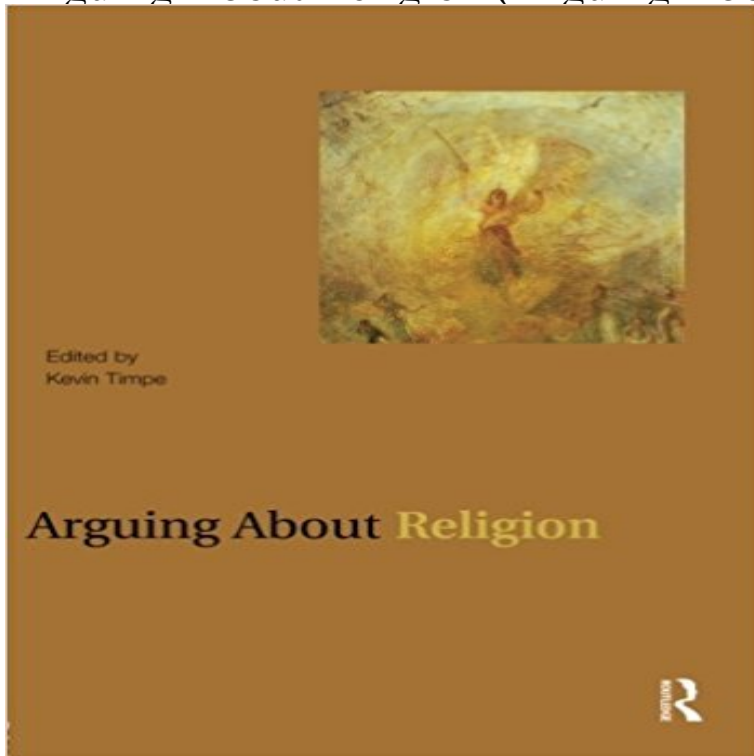


Arguing About Religion (Arguing About Philosophy)
